

Declaration regarding data protection according to the GDPR Cardiovascular Research Days 2024

With this data protection declaration we would like to inform you about the basic aspects of data processing according to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) at the Medical University Vienna (MedUni) in connection with this event.

Data Processing

The data which you provide via the registration form (e.g. your name, address, email) will be processed for the purpose of organising and administering the event.

In addition to registering, you also have the opportunity to submit an abstract. The abstracts are collected by the MedUni and the Ludwig Boltzmann Institute (LBI) for the congress, made available to the public by the speakers as a presentation or poster and will be printed in a conference volume. After the congress the abstracts will not be kept at the MedUni and will be deleted.

By providing your data you consent to the processing of your data. This implied consent forms the legal basis for the processing pursuant to Art 6 (1) lit a of the General Data Protection Regulation. Your data is required in order to be able to administer your participation in the event.

You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time with effect for the future.

The data will be shared with the LBI.

The event is subject to a fee, which is why the invoice data is stored for a period of 7 years.

Your Rights

You are generally entitled to the rights of access (get the information what data about you is processed), rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, data portability and objection.

If you are of the opinion that the processing of your data violates data protection law or that your data protection rights have been violated in any other way, you can lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (Österreichische Datenschutzbehörde - Austrian Data Protection Authority, dsb.gv.at).
